



CURRICULUM LICENSE AGREEMENT

DEFINITIONS

The Licensee: Individual, school, church, company, or organization licensing the Curriculum

The Site: The individual, school, church, company, or organization using the Curriculum

The Curriculum: Collectively, all versions and format of the projects (guides, trainings, resources, files, workbooks, or other publication or documents prepared on behalf of Starlight Ministries, Inc.

1. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

- a. Licensee acknowledges the curriculum is license, not sold to the Licensee for us only under the terms and conditions of this license. If Licensee does not agree to the terms of this License, Licensee must not install, download, access, or use the Curriculum, and Licensee must promptly return the curriculum and this Proof of Licensee to Starlight Ministries, Inc.
- b. The Licensee acknowledges the site address or other identification set forth on the license is correct.
- c. The Licensee has agreed to and signed this agreement by opening, saving, downloading, copying, duplicating, printing, transferring, or otherwise using Starlight Ministries, Inc. copyrighted Curriculum. Licensee agrees to the following conditions:
 - a. The Licensee has been granted a non-exclusive license to deliver, present, and/or instruct Starlight Ministries, Inc. copyrighted Curriculum. No presentation, delivery, duplication, or instruction of the Curriculum is licensed, granted, afforded, expressed or implied to individuals, groups, associations, gatherings or meetings of persons assembled outside the physical boundaries of the Licensee's Site.
 - b. No omissions, additions, or changes will be made to Starlight Ministries Inc copyrighted Curriculum.
 - c. Licensee acknowledges that Starlight Ministries, Inc. is the sole owner of its Curriculum and a copyrighted instructional material or resources that are

part of the Curriculum, including but not limited to this document, any and all other electronic downloaded documents, presentation files, online content, resources, support materials and any other Curriculum items.

- d. No Starlight Ministries, Inc. Curriculum, whole or in part, including but not limited to all Curriculum materials owned and copyrighted by Starlight Ministries, Inc. may be used in the creation of a new or adapted course by Licensee for teaching instruction, or distribution without written permission of an authorized officer of Starlight Ministries, Inc.

2. AUTHORIZED USERS

- a. The Curriculum may be used by the Licensee only at the site(s) address(es) on the license. If the licensee has more than one location all sites must be listed on the License Agreement.
- b. The Curriculum may only be used by all enrolled employees of the Licensee, at the site address. Temporary employees, volunteers, contractors, and consultants of Licensee who work on-site at Licensee's facilities may also use the Curriculum in connection with the operation of the business of Licensee. Any copies of the Curriculum used by temporary employees, volunteers, contractors, and consultants must be removed from such individual's computers once they cease working at Licensee's facilities.
- c. Licensee will use commercially reasonable efforts to restrict network or any other access to the Curriculum by anyone outside of the Licensee's facilities who is not authorized to use the Curriculum.

3. TERMS OF USE

- a. Upon payment of all applicable fees and subject to the terms of this license, Starlight Ministries, Inc. grants the Licensee a non-exclusive, perpetual (unless terminated under Section 8), non-transferable license to use the Curriculum at the Licensee's site.
- b. Starlight Ministries, Inc. has provided Licensee with unique access to the Curriculum. This is the Licensee's proof of license to use the Curriculum, and it will be required for upgrade or support services. This information must be kept confidential.
- c. Licensee has the right to print an unlimited number of guides, workbooks, resources, and documents that are part of the Curriculum for use by Authorized Users at the Site.
- d. Licensee has the right to transfer an unlimited number of guides, workbooks, resources, and documents that are part of the Curriculum to an unlimited number of devices at the Site for use by Authorized Users at the Site.
- e. Licensee has the right to place the Curriculum onto a memory device, local computer, LAN server, or cloud-based server for the purpose of distributing files for

use by Authorized Users at the Site. Posting files in the public domain on the internet is prohibited.

- f. Authorized Users may also use the Curriculum on the Licensee's desktop and portable devices which, on a temporary basis, are away from the Licensee's facilities provided that it is for the purpose of using the Curriculum at the Site.
- g. Resource files that are part of the Curriculum may be customized for the purpose of meeting the Site's objectives, on the understanding that the copyright information is displayed with all the files, the Starlight Ministries, Inc. logo is intact and the copyright remains with Starlight Ministries, Inc.
- h. Resource files that are part of the Curriculum may be annotated using a PDF reader for the purpose of completion and/or submission.
- i. Licensee shall be solely responsible for all expenses incurred in the printing, distribution, and implementation of the Curriculum by Licensee.
- j. Licensee may make one copy of Curriculum for the sole purpose of creating a backup file.

4. OWNERSHIP

- a. Licensee owns the media on which the Curriculum is recorded or fixed, but Licensee acknowledges that Starlight Ministries, Inc. retains ownership of the Curriculum itself. Starlight Ministries, Inc. reserves any rights not expressly granted to Licensee. The rights granted are limited to Starlight Ministries, Inc's intellectual property rights in the Curriculum and do not include any other patents or intellectual property rights.

5. LIMITED WARRANTY AND LIABILITY

- a. All reasonable precautions have been taken in the preparation of the Curriculum, including both technical and non-technical proof reading. Starlight Ministries, Inc. and all staff, volunteers, and or an authorize agent, assume no responsibility for any errors or submissions.
- b. Starlight Ministries, Inc. and or an authorized agent shall not be responsible for any direct incidental, or consequential damages arising from the use of the Curricula. While the Curriculum is regularly scanned for viruses, it is the Licensee responsibility to check all files supplied by Starlight Ministries, Inc. and an authorized agent, prior to use.
- c. Straight Ministries, Inc. warrants for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of purchase of this License that the Curriculum as provided by Starlight Ministries, Inc. will be in accordance with the accompanying documentation.
- d. Starlight Ministries, Inc. entire liability and Licensee's sole and exclusive remedy for any breach of the foregoing limited warranty will be, at Straight Ministries, Inc's option, replacement of the Curriculum, refund of the purchase price, or repair or replacement of the Curriculum which is returned to Starlight Ministries, Inc.

- e. No refund will be given in the event of inadequate hardware or network systems at the Licensee's Site resulting in the inability to install resource files or complete assignments as outlined in the Curriculum.
- f. No refund will be given in the event Authorized Users lack the knowledge for installing or implementing the Curriculum.
- g. No refund will be given in the event of inadequate internet connection at the Licensee's Site resulting in the inability to download Curriculum files from the internet.
- h. No refund will be given in the event of inadequate printing facilities at the Licensee's site resulting in the inability to print the Curriculum.
- i. Starlight Ministries, Inc.'s total liability to Licensee for damages for any cause whatsoever, howsoever caused (whether in contract, negligence or other tort, under statute or otherwise howsoever arising) will be limited to the money paid for the Curriculum that caused the damages.

6. RESTRICTIONS

- a. Distance learning is prohibited. This restriction applies to the use of the Internet, Intranet, and CD-EOM/DVD's for use with participants.
- b. The Licensee may not sell, lend, lease, rent, assign, or transfer the Curriculum to another party in any form.
- c. The Licensee may not translate, reverse engineer, de-compile, disassemble or create derivative works based upon the Curriculum or any part thereof.
- d. The Licensee may not circumvent security features that protect the copyright holder, Starlight Ministries, Inc.
- e. The Licensee is strictly forbidden from posting the Curriculum in any format which makes it accessible to non-authorized users.

7. TERMINATION

- a. This licensing agreement shall continue as long as the Licensee uses the Curriculum. However, it will terminate if the Licensee fails to comply with any of its terms or conditions.
- b. If any breach of this License by the Licensee occurs, Starlight Ministries, Inc. may terminate this License, whereupon this License and all rights granted to Licensee herein shall immediately cease.
- c. The Licensee agrees, upon termination, to destroy any printed Curriculum, delete files from computers, and return all digital copies of the Curriculum to Starlight Ministries, Inc.

8. GENERAL TERMS

- a. Licensing Curriculum from Starlight Ministries, Inc. indicates the Licensee acceptance of these terms and restrictions and violation will be prosecuted in the full extent of the law.
- b. If any provision of this license is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable such provisions shall be severed from the licensing agreement, however the other provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
- c. No documentation provided by Starlight Ministries, Inc. may be copied without written permission from Starlight Ministries, Inc. unless produced under the terms of the License.
- d. Starlight Ministries, Inc. reserves the right to alter licensing conditions at any time, without prior notice. No terms or conditions will affect the Licensee's right as defined under law
